

EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENT

What Is an Educational Assessment?

An educational assessment is a comprehensive evaluation that helps you understand your child's learning strengths and challenges. It can provide insights into:

- Learning difficulties (e.g. dyslexia, dyscalculia)
- Giftedness
- Academic performance compared to age expectations

What's Included in the Assessment?

APPOINTMENT 1 *Parent interview (1hr)*

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A collaborative discussion exploring:

- Learning history
- Developmental milestones
- Current concerns at home and school
- Educational, medical, and family background

APPOINTMENT 2 *Cognitive Assessment (2hrs)*

WISC-V (ages 6–16) or WPPSI-IV (ages 2.5–7)

Assesses:

- Verbal comprehension
- Visual-spatial skills
- Fluid reasoning
- Working memory
- Processing speed

APPOINTMENT 3 *Academic Assessment (2hrs)*

Tool: WIAT-III

Evaluates:

- Reading and comprehension
- Writing and spelling
- Maths skills
- Oral language abilities

APPOINTMENT 4 *Specialist Literacy & Numeracy Testing (2 hours)*

- YARC – Reading fluency & comprehension
- CTOPP-2 – Phonological processing (linked to reading difficulties)
- KEYMATHS-3 – In-depth understanding of mathematical concepts

APPOINTMENT 5 *Teacher/Tutor consultation (30 mins)*

With your permission, we consult your child's teacher or tutor to gather insights into classroom performance, learning behaviour, and social-emotional functioning.

APPOINTMENT 6 *Feedback Session (1hr)*

- Clear explanation of assessment findings
- Diagnosis (if applicable)
- Tailored strategies for home and school
- Comprehensive written report with results and recommendations

Fees

With a General Psychologist: \$2600 Deposit of \$400 then 4 instalments x \$550 paid across the assessment appointments. If we do not require all assessment sessions to answer your referral cost, then the overall cost is reduced.

With a Provisional Psychologist: \$1,900 Deposit of \$300 deposit and 4 instalments of \$400 paid across the assessment appointments
